Additionally, your essay should meet the following guidelines:

- Between 450 and 600 words
- 1” margins on all sides
- Times New Roman 12 pt typeface
- No title page necessary
- Double-spaced
- Typed; handwritten essays will not be accepted.
- Cite at least three sources in making your argument, using APA or MLA style
- No attachments or appendices allowed, with the exception of a reference list as appropriate
- Proofread multiple times, and free of all spelling, grammar, and formatting errors

➤ If selected, each scholarship recipient must submit a certified copy of his or her college registration/course schedule to Business Professionals of America-Michigan Association. After receiving this documentation of enrollment, BPA will send the scholarship money directly to the college or university.
